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Tickets Now on Sale for Art Project Los Angeles, Taking Place September 17 at Bonhams in Hollywood

Juried competition to find the featured artist for the sixth annual art auction and reception fundraiser for APLA is open until July 17

(Los Angeles, CA; July 11, 2016)—APLA is excited to announce that **tickets are now on sale** for the sixth installment of Art Project Los Angeles on Saturday, September 17, at Bonhams auction house in Hollywood. The evening, which features a live and silent art auction as well as a catered cocktail reception, will begin at 6 p.m.

Art Project Los Angeles is also still accepting submissions for the second annual juried competition to find a featured artist of the event before the deadline on July 17. The chosen artist's work will be a centerpiece of the evening's live auction and will also be prominently featured in the Art Project catalog and promotional materials. Proceeds from all of the artworks that are auctioned off at the event will benefit APLA to fund health care and HIV support services we provide to more than 14,000 people in Los Angeles County annually.

Auction items will range from paintings, prints, and photography to sculpture, jewelry, and other unique pieces from both world-renowned and local, up-and-coming artists. Past live auctions have featured iconic artworks by Keith Haring, Ed Ruscha, Pablo Picasso, and Andy Warhol, to name just a few.

Submissions to the juried competition should be clean and in good condition, and framed submissions are preferred. Due to limited space, artwork should not exceed 48"x 60", and sculptures should be securely attached to a base. Submission forms can be downloaded at www.artprojectlosangeles.com.
